Create a quilt that represents your take on being “Green”. This could be an environmental message, to just a quilt using a recycled material, to lots of things in between.

RULES

- ⌘ Entrant must be a member of Bits ‘n’ Pieces Quilt Guild AND the maker and the quilter of your entry.
- ⌘ You may choose your own fabric, materials, and techniques – anything from traditional quilting to art quilting, hand and/or machine quilting, and/or all types of embellishments.
- ⌘ Include whatever you want: Fabric, paper, metal, plastic, flea market or garage sale finds, old quilt blocks, lint, old piping, old binding, etc. (Check out St. Louis Teachers’ Recycle Center at Crestwood Court ArTSpace (in the old Crestwood Plaza). The hours are Saturday 10 AM to 1 PM,, Tuesday (1st and 3rd) 2 - 6 PM, and by appointment, 636-227-7095, www.sltrc.com .

- ⌘ On the front of the quilt, you **MUST** include the following:
 - ⌘ **Something GREEN**
 - ⌘ **Something Recycled, Reused, Repurposed, Re-crafted or Re-imagined**
- ⌘ Quilt must be a quilt with three layers and held together in some way.
- ⌘ The minimum finished size can be 30" x 30" and the maximum can be 40" x 40".
- ⌘ Quilts must be a single unit and not framed with wood, metal, etc.
- ⌘ Members may submit a maximum of two quilts.
- ⌘ Please do NOT include your name on the front of the quilt.
- ⌘ Quilts must have been finished between April 27, 2009 and early March 2010 and be in excellent condition.
- ⌘ Quilt cannot have previously been shown in any other show.
- ⌘ A Quilt Label must be stitched or securely attached to the back lower edge of the quilt and include the following information:
 - ⌘ Quilt name
 - ⌘ Date made
 - ⌘ "Easy Being Green" Bits 'n' Pieces Quilt Guild 2010 Challenge
 - ⌘ Your name
 - ⌘ List of items on your quilt front that are recycled, reused, repurposed, re-crafted or re-imagined
 - ⌘ Dimensions of your quilt
 - ⌘ **NO PHOTO** on your show registration
- ⌘ A Hanging Sleeve must be attached to the top/back of your quilt for displaying in the Fanfare of Quilts 2010 show.
- ⌘ Please **NO** perishables, real plants or real animal parts! If your quilt has any of these, it will be rejected from the Challenge.
- ⌘ Incomplete, torn, soiled quilts, over/under dimension requirements will not qualify for entry or exhibition.
