

## Appliqué Block 6 (July 2013)

### Four swords squares

This block uses three contrasting fabrics (B, C and D) on the same background fabric (A) as other appliqué blocks

- (A) Cut one 9 ½ inch square for appliqué background
- (B) Cut four 2 ¼ inch squares
- (C) Cut four pieces from template below (seam allowances are NOT included)
- (D) cut one 1 ½ inch diameter circle
- Four 1 ½ inch pieces of ¼ inch fusible tape (I made a tube from fabric (B) finished ¼" x 1 ½")

### Construction

Mark vertical, horizontal and diagonal lines through the center of A square. Arrange and se the block, using the diagram as a guide. Start with the template pieces. Press under the squares ¼". Hem all around each B square. Position B squares and bias tape, tucking the ends of the bias tape under the squares. Appliqué the circle to the block center last.
